



## 6 Ways to Get Students Involved

1. Let PACN offer a prize that appeals to students' stomachs, such as donuts or pizza for the winning grade level.
2. Have students in leadership make posters each day of the week to illustrate how much their grade level has raised.
3. Ask your school's student council to plan a baby-themed pep rally to announce the total amount of money raised. Be sure to include stroller races and the mystery baby food game eaten out of baby diapers! Students love to see administration involved as well!
